

Photographic Competition

Terms and Conditions

- The competition is open to any age and free to enter. There will be an adult and a junior category. Entrants for “junior” category must be under 14 on the day the competition closes.
- Closing date is **April 1st 2020**. Photo entries should be handed in (or posted to) Harvest Farm Shop in Okehampton (5, Red Lion Yard, EX20 1SN)
- All photos to have been taken by entrant and can be a favourite photo from past or present.
- Photo entries are best on photographic paper but may also be printed on paper. Max size A4. Entrants name and the category number entered to be written on reverse of each image.
- Entries to be judged on subject matter.
- A caption or short description can be included with each photo.
- Entries must have been photographed in the United Kingdom.
- Wildlife photographed in British zoos is not eligible
- A picture that has already won a prize in a major national or international competition cannot be entered.
- Please respect the country code and always put animal welfare first.
- Please tell us on your entry form if you would like your photos returned. Photos can be collected from shop after judging or include a SAE to return. Make sure you save a copy.
- Please be advised members of the public will view photos, only enter pictures you are happy for others to see, i.e., other family members, people in the picture.
- First prize and runners up will be awarded to winning photos in each category. The judge may award a joint award and a highly commended award. A best in section will then be chosen for a public vote.
- The 12 winning photographs will be used to make our very own Harvest Workers’ Co-op 2021 calendar. The best winning pictures from each category will be displayed at an exhibition open to the public at Okehampton Church Hall. There will be a public vote for the best photo.
- All images submitted to the 2020 Photography Competition may be used by Harvest Workers’ Co-op on their social media accounts, website, publications and future promotional materials (with full credit) unless specifically stated by the photographer. By submitting images to the competition and not informing us of any objections, you are agreeing to our terms. Copyright will always remain with the photographer.
- The winning photo from each section will win a prize of the 2021 Harvest calendar.
